The Prince George Chamber of Commerce is extremely pleased to add our support for the Northwood Pulpmill Green Transformation and the PGI Mills Green Transformation projects to that of others already received.

Improved air quality is important to the business community of Prince George. The very real impact that air quality has on our health and what it does to business sustainability; our ability to attract skilled workers and professionals to our community; the unpleasant odour and negative perception of the liveability of our community created in the minds of future investors; are all reasons for the Chamber of Commerce to support these initiatives.

In addition to the significant stimulus to the Prince George economy, long-term mill viability and reductions in greenhouse gas emissions; these projects represent four key improvements in Prince George air quality. They are:

- Lowering of odour emissions through conversion to a Low Odour Boiler.
- The addition of an Electrostatic Precipitator (ESP) to include Best Achievable Technology equipment to reduce particulate levels in the community.
- Northwood Green Transformation also includes the addition of a new ESP to achieve significant reduction in particulate emissions from the upgraded Low Odour Recovery Boiler.

The recent KPMG report has ranked Prince George as one of the top 10 places in which to do business. These projects will add to that ranking by:

- Creating Economic stimulus for the community during engineering and construction
- Creating long term economic and job stability through improved viability of the mills
