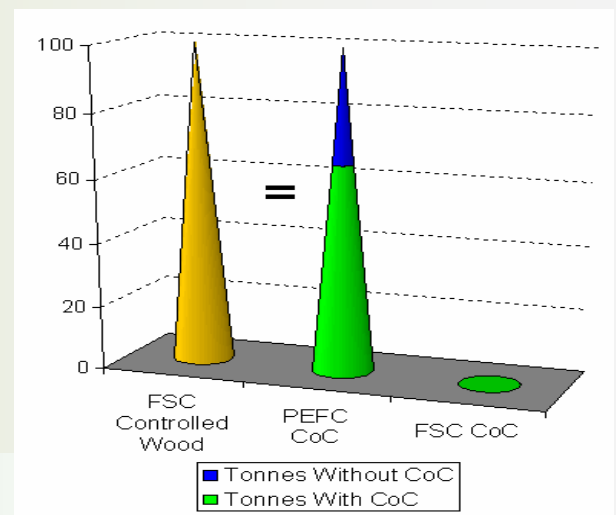
Certification News from Canfor Pulp L.P.

On August 18th 2008, Canfor Pulp Limited Partnership (CPLP) received its FSC Controlled Wood and its Chain of Custody certifications. The certification numbers were SW-CW-003366 and SW-COC-003366 and they are valid until August 17th 2013. This was the latest in the certification achievements for CPLP, we had operated a PEFC Chain of Custody since 2005 and Howe Sound mill had received its PEFC Chain of Custody in February 2007.

Canfor Pulp can offer customers who wish to use certified pulp in their products a range of options today:

1. For those customers who are producing a product carrying a PEFC certification, we can supply certified pulp from any of our mills. At this moment the supply from Prince George, Intercon and Northwood mills is relatively abundant, the supply from Howe Sound mill is more limited, but we are committed to seeing it grow to meet growing demands. If you require some of this PEFC certified pulp it will be supplied under the Volume Credit system, please speak to your Canfor sales contact to arrange for your supply. (certificate attached)
2. For those customers who are producing products carrying an FSC Mixed Sources label, they will be blending a volume of pulp that has come from an FSC certified forest with pulp that meets the standards defined by FSC for Controlled Wood. Rather than conducting the risk assessments themselves, a lengthy and time consuming process, the customer can rely on their suppliers Controlled Wood certification to provide this assurance, if their supplier has one. This is the case even when the suppliers fibre does not originate in an FSC certified forest. All the pulp being produced at the Prince George, Intercon and Northwood mills today meets this standard. (certificate attached) Howe Sound is undergoing their Controlled wood certification and expect to have it in place in early 2009.
3. For the customers who need a supply of FSC certified pulp, we are unable to supply any today. The certified fibre that we have from Forests certified under the PEFC system can only be sold under the PEFC Chain of Custody. In the central interior of BC there is currently no forestry certification under the FSC standard, almost all of the forests in the region have been certified under one of the PEFC compatible standards (Canadian Standards Association SFM (CSA - Z809) or Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI)) and have been for many years. Since CPLP do not manage any forests directly, we are reliant on the certification approaches which our suppliers have adopted and no FSC processes are underway today. If and when FSC certified wood chips do become available in the BC interior, the FSC Chain of Custody which we have will allow us to process the fibre into FSC certified pulp.
4. We can also provide dual certified pulps, pulps certified under both the PEFC Chain of Custody and the FSC Controlled Wood standard if required. This is illustrated in the graphic on the right.
